WHY TRAIN WITH ABC OF INDIANA / KENTUCKY FOR YOUR CAREER IN THE TRADES?

ABC of Indiana/Kentucky offers a wide variety of trades in which to train. The classes offered at each location depend on enrollment numbers.

During the first semester, Indiana apprentices earn the following safety certifications while enrolled in the CORE curriculum:

- **OSHA 10 Hour**
- Qualified Rigging
- **Qualified Signal Person**
- Fork Lift Training

Learning modules within each trade are also open to students who need a refresher on a specific topic or just want to take a class on a certain subject.

ABC of Indiana/Kentucky consistently improves and upgrades curriculum to meet industry and Department of Labor standards. ABC of Indiana/Kentucky instructors are

experts in their trades and certified by the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER).

Classes are one night a week from 5-9:00 p.m. and include classroom instruction, hands-on learning activities in the training lab, and on-thejob learning.

Apprentices have the opportunity to earn an Associates Degree from Vincennes University.

Find Out Why WIOA Becoming Law is Huge News for ABC Members

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) was signed into law July 22 and has the potential to create great opportunities for ABC members who have been looking for skilled workers to fill the labor shortage. Here's how it directly affects ABC members:

WIOA authorizes \$9.5 billion dollars in training funds

This money dedicated to workforce development and training is an important step in ensuring workers develop the skills they need so the nation's workforce can keep up with economic demand.

It makes it easier for construction companies to train their workforce

- ·Employers can now become a training provider without needing to qualify at the local level.
- Companies who train can now get reimbursed for on-the job training, incumbent training and customized training—including assistance with up to 90% of a trainee's wages, in some cases.
- WIOA offers an alternative to a competitive grant by paying these companies through a training account on a per-trainee basis.

WIOA shifts the focus onto making workforce training effective

- WIOA's goal is to get employers actively engaged and focused on training for in-demand jobs.
- •It is significantly more streamlined than its predecessor, the Workforce Investment Act, which expired in 2003.
- It ensures small businesses have the opportunity to participate in developing training programs that will train people for available career opportunities.
- It allows existing construction craft training programs and others that provide workers with industry-recognized credentials to use workforce investment funding.

Now what? Here's how to get involved

- Work with a local ABC chapter to get started (use the chapter locator map to find a chapter).
- •Contact a local American Job Center (One-Stop) to become involved in workforce initiatives, get qualified to become a training provider and get reimbursed.*
- Reach out to a state Office of Workforce Investment for additional information on how to get involved with the new law in place.



Recent fatalities serve as a reminder to protect workers from demolition hazards

On June 20, a construction worker taking down a Blockbuster Video building in New Jersey was trapped and killed when the last standing wall collapsed on top of him. Six months earlier, a 25-year-old construction worker in Chicago was struck and killed by pieces of falling concrete while conducting renovations on a shopping mall. A year ago, six people were killed and 14 injured in Philadelphia when a four-story building undergoing demolition collapsed. All these deaths could have been prevented.

OSHA recently launched updates to its <u>Demolition Webpage</u> that focuses on the serious hazards common in demolition operations. The page includes information safe practices that must be followed to prevent injuries and fatalities, and a link for stakeholders to share stories about demolition safety.
