OVERVIEW:

Did you know that "Powered Industrial Trucks" (i.e. forklifts) are always among OSHA's most frequently cited standards? In fact, it was #6 overall in 2013! According to OSHA's law, anyone who operates a forklift, even for a brief period of time, must be trained. Trying to stay current with Operator training can be a challenge and very costly, especially with high turnover.

OSHA requires trainers to have knowledge, training & experience. This course will give students the knowledge & training they need to conduct the training internally. *Please note that trainers must also have experience with operating the type of forklift they will train on, which will not be accomplished through this course.*
